

NECESSARY.....

- Sleepwear
- Socks and underwear
- O Tennis shoes and/or hiking boots
- Water shoes or old tennis shoes to canoe
- O Flip flops for showering (but no sandals around camp!)
- *Shirts or T-shirts
- Shorts
- O Jeans and/or sweatpants
- O Long sleeve shirt & long pants for paintball
- *Sweatshirt or light jacket
- O Pillow & sleeping bag (or XL twin sheets and blanket)
- *Water bottles
- *Small backpack
- *Flashlight with extra batteries

- O Toothbrush and toothpaste
- Shampoo, shower gel
- O Hair items
- O Tote for taking items to the shower
- Sunscreen, chapstick, tissues
- *Laundry bag, plastic bag, or pillowcase for laundry
- O Bath towel, hand towel, washcloth per camper
- O Poncho or raincoat, hat
- If a member of the Y's Ragger Society, bring your last Rag received
- Western clothes to wear at **Cowboy Cookout!**
- Medications
- Money for our Camp Store!

- Twin foam pad recommended for adults
- O Pack 'n Play for little campers
- Walkie Talkies helpful in communication with family members
- 2-gallon water jug plus cups
- Camp chairs
- O Bug repellent
- Wet Wipes

- O Power strip (there is only one outlet per cabin)
- Cell phone and charger
- O Coffee is available in dining hall, but some enjoy having a coffee set-up for their cabin

WEATHER: Because of the higher elevation, expect the temperature to be about 10-20 degrees cooler during the day than in the Valley. At night, temperatures can be 15-25 degrees colder. Check the weather before packing - Groom Creek 86303
